**ORV Rally:** Tammy Budrow said she was putting on an ORV Rally. The DNR will be involved in this. This will be on the first Saturday in October. There will be different check points in town and out of town for a total of 18 checkpoints. This is not a timed race. It is meant to be done at leisure. More points will be added if money is spent at local businesses. This will be about a 40 mile trip with prizes to be given away during the event. This will possibly be an annual event. The event is on October 5<sup>th</sup>.

**Scarecrow Festival:** The banner is being made and will be placed put up when done. This event will fall under the village insurance and the chamber website will advertises it but it is Rita's event. The event will be from 11-2pm on October 12<sup>th</sup>.

**Treasurers Report:** Burdzy gave out handouts of income and expenses associated with the 4<sup>th</sup> of July. There was a total of about \$30.000 all together in donations.
